1 18VAC80-10-10. Definitions.

- 2 The following words and terms, when used in this chapter, shall have the following
- 3 meanings unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 4 "Administrative Process Act" means Chapter 40 (§2.2-4000 et seq.) of Title 2.2 of the
- 5 Code of Virginia.
- 6 "Agency" means any authority, instrumentality, officer, board, or other unit of state
- 7 government empowered by the basic laws to make regulations or decide cases the Board
- 8 for Hearing Aid Specialists.
- 9 "Notification lists" means lists used by the board to notify persons pursuant to this
- 10 chapter. Such lists may include electronic mailing lists or regular mailing lists
- maintained by the board.
- "Organization" means any one or more associations association, advisory council,
- committee, corporation, partnership, governmental body or legal entity.
- "Person" means one or more individuals.

15 18VAC80-10-20. Mailing list Notification lists.

- 16 The agency will maintain a list lists of persons and organizations who will be mailed the
- 17 following documents, or notification of how to obtain a copy of the documents
- 18 electronically, as they become available:
- 19 1. "Notice of Intended Regulatory Action" to promulgate, amend or repeal regulations.
- 20 2. "Notice of Comment Period" and public hearings.
- 21 3. Notice that the final regulations have been adopted.
- 22 Failure of these persons and organizations a person or organization to receive the
- documents for any reason shall not affect the validity of any regulations otherwise
- properly adopted under the Administrative Process Act, §9-6.14:1 (§2.2-4000 et seq. of
- 25 the Code of Virginia).

26 **18VAC80-10-30.** Placement on the mailing notification list; deletion.

- 27 Any person or organization wishing to be placed on the mailing list may do so by
- 28 electronic notification or by writing the agency. In addition, the agency, at its discretion,
- 29 may add to the list any person, organization, or publication it believes will serve the
- 30 purpose of responsible participation in the formation or promulgation of regulations.
- 31 Persons Each person and organization on the list will be provided all information stated

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- 1 in 18VAC80-10-20. Individuals and organizations A person or organization periodically
- 2 may be requested to indicate their desire to continue to receive documents or be deleted
- 3 from the list. When mail is returned as undeliverable, individuals and organizations the
- 4 person or organization will be deleted from the list. When electronic notifications are
- 5 returned as undeliverable over more than one day, the person or organization may be
- 6 <u>deleted from the list.</u>

7 18VAC80-10-40. Petition for rulemaking.

- 8 Any person <u>or organization</u> may petition the agency to adopt <u>consider</u> or amend <u>review</u>
- 9 any regulation. Any petition received shall appear on the next agenda of the agency. The
- agency shall consider and respond to the petition within 180 days pursuant to §2.2-4007
- 11 A of the Code of Virginia. The agency shall have sole authority to dispose of the petition.

12 **18VAC80-10-50.** Notice of intent.

- 13 At least 30 days prior to filing the "Notice of Comment Period" and proposed regulations
- as required by §9-6.14:7.1 2.2-4007 of the Code of Virginia, the agency will publish a
- 15 "Notice of Intended Regulatory Action." This notice will provide for at least a 30-day
- 16 comment period and shall state whether the agency intends to hold a public hearing. The
- agency is required to hold a hearing on the proposed regulation upon request by (i) the
- Governor or (ii) 25 or more persons. Further, the notice shall describe the subject matter
- and intent of the planned regulation. Such notice shall be transmitted to the Registrar of
- 20 Regulations for inclusion in The Virginia Register of Regulations.

21 18VAC80-10-60. Informational proceedings or public hearings for existing rules.

- Within two years of the promulgation of a regulation, the agency shall evaluate it for
- 23 effectiveness and continued need. The agency shall conduct an informal proceeding,
- 24 which may take the form of a public hearing, to receive public comment on existing
- 25 regulation. Notice of such proceedings shall be transmitted to the Registrar of
- 26 Regulations for inclusion in The Virginia Register of Regulations. Such proceedings may
- be held separately or in conjunction with other informational proceedings.

28 18VAC80-10-70. Notice of formulation and adoption.

- 29 At any meeting of the agency or a subcommittee where it is anticipated the formation or
- 30 adoption of regulation will occur, the subject matter shall be transmitted to the Registrar
- 31 of Regulations for inclusion in The Virginia Register of Regulations.
- 32 If there are one or more changes with have substantial impact on a regulation, then any
- person may petition the agency within 30 days from the publication of the final regulation
- 34 to request an opportunity for oral or written submittals on the changes to the regulations.
- 35 If the agency receives requests from at least 25 persons for an opportunity to make oral or
- written comment, then the agency shall suspend the regulatory process for 30 days to

- 1 solicit additional public comment, unless the agency determines that the changes made
- 2 are minor or inconsequential in their impact.
- 3 If the Governor finds that one or more changes with substantial impact have been made
- 4 to proposed regulation, then he may suspend the regulatory process for 30 days to require
- 5 the agency to solicit further public comment on the changes to the regulation.
- 6 A draft of the agency's summary description of public comment shall be sent by the
- 7 agency to all public commenters on the proposed regulation at least five days before final
- 8 adoption of the regulation.

9 18VAC80-10-80. Advisory committees.

- 10 The agency intends to appoint advisory committees as it deems necessary to provide
- adequate participation in the formation, promulgation, adoption, and review of
- regulations. Such committees are particularly appropriate when other interested parties
- may possess specific expertise in the area of proposed regulation. The advisory
- committee shall only provide recommendations to the agency and shall not participate in
- any final decision making actions on a regulation.
- When identifying potential advisory committee members the agency may use the
- 17 following:
- 18 1. Directories of organizations related to the profession;
- 2. Industry, professional and trade associations' mailing lists; and or
- 20 3. Lists of persons who have previously participated in public proceedings concerning
- 21 this or a related issue.

22 **18VAC80-10-90.** Applicability.

- 23 18VAC80-10-20, 18VAC80-10-30, 18VAC80-10-40, 18VAC80-10-60 and 18VAC80-
- 24 10-70 shall apply to all regulations promulgated and adopted in accordance with §9-
- 25 6.14:9 2.2-4012 of the Code of Virginia except those regulations promulgated in
- 26 accordance with §9-6.14:4.1 2.2-4002, 2.2-4006, 2.2-4011, 2.2-4012.1, 2.2-4018, or 2.2-
- 27 4025 of the Administrative Process Act.
