I have reviewed the proposed amendments issued by the Board for Barbers and Cosmetologists. In my view, as counsel to the Board for Barbers and Cosmetologists, the Board may promulgate these regulations pursuant to § 54.1-201 of the *Code of Virginia*. The regulations do not appear, on their face, to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with federal or state law currently in effect.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only, is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed, regulations, and does not address, or express a position on, matters of public policy.
