Subject: Letter of Assurance for Proposed Common Interest Community Manager Regulations 18 VAC 48-50

I have reviewed the Common Interest Community Board's proposed amendment of its manager licensing regulations, particularly 18 VAC 48-50-140, that were listed on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall Internet site on April 13, 2010. In my view, as counsel to the Common Interest Community Board, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to §§ 54.1-201(5), and 54.1-2349 of the *Code of Virginia*. The regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect. Further, these amendments are exempt from the requirements of the Virginia Administrative Process Act, pursuant to § 2.2 – 4006.A.3 and § 2.2 – 4006.A.4.a of the *Code of Virginia*.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
