Re: *Proposed Revisions to Tied-House Regulations*

Dear Mr. Coleburn:

In response to your request, I have reviewed the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board's proposed revisions to the Tied-House regulations.

Based on that review, I find that the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board ("the Board") has the authority to promulgate the amendments to 3VAC 5-30-10 A, 3VAC 5-30-10 B (3)(g), 3VAC 5-30-30 (C)(2), 3VAC 5-30-60 D, 3VAC 5-30-60 H, and the previously numbered 3VAC 5-30-70 (C)(5), pursuant to Sections 4.1-103 (13) and 4.1-111 (B)(3) of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended. Those provisions, read in concert with Section 4.1-111(A) of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended, also authorize the Board to repeal 3VAC 5-30-40, and 3 VAC 5-30-70 (C)(4).

I also find that the proposed amendments are consistent with the statutory grant of authority to promulgate them, are consistent with the statutes, and are internally consistent. The proposed amendments do not appear to run afoul of state or federal statutes. I further find that the proposed amendments have no Constitutional defect.
