### Summary

This action is to repeal 6VAC15-62, Standards for State Community Corrections Units, as unneeded.

These regulations were established under authority of §53.1-5 of the Code of Virginia which was changed by Chapter 375 of the 2011 Acts of the General Assembly so that the Board of Corrections no longer has the authority to set standards for probation and parole districts.

### Statement of final agency action

The Board of Corrections voted on October 19, 2011 to repeal 6VAC15-62, Standards for State Community Corrections Units.
