12VAC35-105

I have reviewed the proposed amendments to 12VAC35-105, the *Rules and Regulations for Licensing Providers by the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services*, which were adopted by the Board of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services on October 4, 2017. The Board has the authority to promulgate these emergency regulations pursuant to 2017 Va. Acts ch. 136, 2017 Va. Acts ch. 418, and Virginia Code § 37.2-203. The proposed emergency regulations are constitutional and do not conflict with existing federal or state laws or regulations.
