The Virginia Marine Resources Commission (VMRC) is repealing Chapter 4VAC20-980-10 et seq., "Pertaining to On-Shore Loading and Unloading of Shellfish from Condemned Areas" to increase regulatory efficiency by reducing regulatory requirements found in other chapters.

Mandate and Impetus

[Mandate] VMRC is authorized by § 28.2-201 of the Code of Virginia to promulgate regulations and guidelines necessary to carry out the provisions of Title 28.2, including marine shellfish regulations.

[Impetus] Current regulations permit the loading and unloading of shellfish in a less restrictive but equally safe manner than that required by 4VAC20-980-10 et seq., and this regulation is no longer required for public safety or efficiency of staff time.
