During its 2021 special session I, the General Assembly enacted Chapters 17 and 478 of the Acts of Assembly which amended the Virginia Fair Housing Law § 36-96.1 et seq of the Code of Virginia effective July 1, 2021. The Real Estate Board and the Fair Housing Board are amending its regulations to conform to the statutory changes made as a result of these amendments. The regulations being amended (18 VAC 135-50 et seq) contain language changing a protected class and clarifying reasonable accommodation as a result of the statutory changes. The amendments conform the relevant regulations to the amended Code of Virginia. The boards are promulgating this regulatory action to conform the regulations to the law and there is no agency discretion pursuant to § 2.2-4006.A.4.a of the Code of Virginia.
