**Re: Repeal current; Promulgate New Regulations; Private Day Schools
for Students with Disabilities**

Dear Dr. Wright:

You ask whether the Virginia Board of Education possesses the requisite statutory authority to promulgate regulations governing the operation of Private Day Schools for Students with Disabilities and Educational Programs Offered in Group Homes and Residential Facilities in the Commonwealth.

Section 22.1-16 vests the Board of Education with the authority to promulgate such regulations as may be necessary to carry out its powers and duties and the provisions of Title 22.1. In my view, therefore, the Board possesses the requisite authority to promulgate these regulations.
