Public Schools in Virginia (Action 4019 / Stage 7814)

I have reviewed the proposed regulation identified above to determine whether the State Board of Education (Board) has the authority to promulgate the regulation and if the regulation comports with applicable state law. Pursuant to the Code of Virginia § 22.1-16, the Board has authority to promulgate regulations to carry out its statutory powers and duties. In addition, § 22.1-253.13:3 of the Code of Virginia specifically requires the Board to promulgate regulations establishing standards for accreditation of Virginia's public schools. Finally, Chapter 720 and Chapter 750 of the 2016 Acts of Assembly direct the Board to promulgate regulations to implement the Profile of a Virginia Graduate and associated revised graduation requirements, which is accomplished through this proposed regulation.

It is this Office's view that the Board has the authority to promulgate this proposed regulation, subject to compliance with the provisions of Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act and Virginia Office of the Governor Executive Order 17 (2014), and that the Board has not exceeded that authority.
