**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mr. Kerr called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. He asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the previous meeting. Mr. Watters moved to accept the minutes. Mr. Craun seconded the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.

**ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT**

Mr. Wilkes provided an update on Milk Commission activity since the last meeting. Much of his time over the summer was dedicated to helping school districts find primary or secondary sources for milk suppliers. The closure of several distribution centers in Virginia and neighboring states has disrupted supply for multiple school districts, with many schools limited in options for fresh milk. He worked with industry groups and the affected districts to find processors and distributors that could provide milk with some success, but not all outcomes were favorable. The Board asked that Mr. Wilkes provide an update on procurement changes for school districts that would better facilitate successful bidding for the next school year.

Ms. Martin added that school milk supply is also limited with the recent shortage of cartons. Several plants that manufactured the packaging have closed in the last year, and the available supply is depleted. This issue has affected schools across the country and will likely persist through early 2024.

**PROPOSED FAST-TRACK ACTION TO AMEND 2 VAC 15-20-81. CLASS PRICES FOR PRODUCER'S MILK, TIME AND METHOD OF PAYMENT, AND BUTTERFAT TESTING.**

Mr. Wilkes introduced a proposed fast-track action to amend 2 VAC 15-20-81. The proposed amendment would change the source of one factor used in the calculation of the Commission's monthly producer Class I milk price from the Virginia Department of Labor and Industry to the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics. Mr. Watters motioned to approve the change, and Mr. Sugumele seconded the motion.

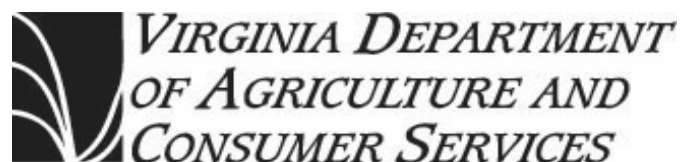

The U.S. Index of prices paid, taxes, and farm wage rates as published in "Agricultural Prices" by the U.S.D.A. will be determined by using the monthly movement of the reweighted and reconstructed prices paid index (PPITW) as published by the U.S.D.A. The monthly movement of the new prices paid index (PPITW) will be applied each month to the preceding month's revised index of prices paid, taxes, and farm wage rates using December 1994 as the base month.

The U.S. Index of prices received as published in "Agricultural Prices" by the U.S.D.A. will be determined by using the monthly movement of the reweighted and reconstructed prices received index as published by the U.S.D.A. The monthly movement of the new prices received index will be applied each month to the preceding month's revised index of prices received using December 1994 as the base month.

The average price per ton paid by all Virginia farmers for 16% dairy feed as published in "Agricultural Prices" by the U.S.D.A. will be determined by using the monthly movement of the index of prices paid, production items, complete feeds as published by the U.S.D.A. The monthly movement of this index will be applied each month to the preceding month's index of 16% dairy feed, Appalachian using April 1995 as the base month.

The U.S. Index of prices paid, taxes, and farm wage rates as published in "Agricultural Prices" by the U.S.D.A. will be determined by using the monthly movement of the reweighted and reconstructed prices paid index (PPITW) as published by the U.S.D.A. The monthly movement of the new prices paid index (PPITW) will be applied each month to the preceding month's revised index of prices paid, taxes, and farm wage rates using December 1994 as the base month.

The U.S. Index of prices received as published in "Agricultural Prices" by the U.S.D.A. will be determined by using the monthly movement of the reweighted and reconstructed prices received index as published by the U.S.D.A. The monthly movement of the new prices received index will be applied each month to the preceding month's revised index of prices received using December 1994 as the base month.

The average price per ton paid by all Virginia farmers for 16% dairy feed as published in "Agricultural Prices" by the U.S.D.A. will be determined by using the monthly movement of the index of prices paid, production items, complete feeds as published by the U.S.D.A. The monthly movement of this index will be applied each month to the preceding month's index of 16% dairy feed, Appalachian using April 1995 as the base month.

## STATE MILK COMMISSION

### POLICY ON PARTICIPATION IN BOARD OF STATE MILK COMMISSION MEETINGS BY ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS PURSUANT TO VA. CODE § 2.2-3708.3

It is the policy of the Board of the State Milk Commission (Board) that individual members of the Board may participate in meetings of the Board by electronic communications as permitted by § 2.2-3708.3 of the Code of Virginia. This policy shall apply to the entire membership and without regard to the identity of the member requesting remote participation or the matters that will be considered or voted on at the meeting.

Whenever an individual member wishes to participate from a remote location, the law requires a quorum of the Board to be physically assembled at the primary or central meeting location.

When such individual participation is due to a personal matter, such participation is limited by law to two meetings per calendar year or 25 percent of the meetings held per calendar year rounded up to the next whole number, whichever is greater.

Further, it is the policy of the Board that the Board may hold all-virtual public meetings pursuant to subsection C of § 2.2-3708.3. Such all-virtual public meetings are also limited by law to two meetings per calendar year or 25 percent of the meetings held per calendar year rounded up to the next whole number, whichever is greater. Additionally, an all-virtual public meeting may not be held consecutively with another all-virtual public meeting.

Requests for remote participation or that the Board conduct an all-virtual public meeting shall be conveyed to the Secretary of the Board, who shall then relay such requests to the President of the Board.

Individual participation from a remote location shall be approved unless such participation would violate this policy or the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (§ 2.2-3700 et seq. of the Code of Virginia). If a member's participation from a remote location is challenged, then the Board shall vote whether to allow such participation.

The request for remote participation or that the Board conduct an all-virtual public meeting shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting. If the Board votes to disapprove of the member's participation because such participation would violate this policy, such disapproval shall be recorded in the minutes with specificity. The minutes shall include other information as required by §§ 2.2-3707 and 2.2-3708.3 depending on the type of remote participation or all-virtual public meeting.

This policy applies to all committees and subcommittees of the Board.
