#### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mr. Kerr called the meeting to order at 1:35 p.m. He asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the previous meeting. Mr. Craun moved to accept the minutes. Ms. Martin seconded the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.

## **FUTURE BOARD MEETINGS**

2024 meeting dates are scheduled for February 21; October 16; and December 4, all in Charlottesville if meeting space is available. A summer meeting may be held if schedules allow.

## **BOARD COMMENTS**

Discussion revolved around school milk distribution issues. The closure of a milk packaging supplier is a growing concern as existing supply runs out. Ms. Martin stated that her half-pint container allocation was recently reduced because of the closure. Mr. Eric Paulson, representing Virginia State Dairymen's Association and attending as a member of the public, provided examples of successful transitions in several school districts from half-pints to bulk dispensers.

## **ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT**

Mr. Wilkes reviewed recent staffing challenges facing the Milk Commission. Two dairy auditor positions were advertised in November through early December but remain unfilled. He reminded attendees that the Dairy Producer Margin Coverage Premium Assistance Program will again run, but applications for reimbursement will not be mailed to Grade A farms until USDA FSA announces that enrollment for the program has begun.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Cost study procedures and results were reviewed. Milk Commission staff analyzed milk processing costs that represent approximately 65% of the milk sold in Virginia to determine the calculated cost to produce milk. Mr. Wilkes noted that the margin between the highest and lowest costs to produce finished units was the smallest it has been in at least a decade, at just \$0.11 for a gallon of whole milk. Costs to distribute milk remained relatively flat, with labor costs offsetting any decreases in diesel fuel costs from the previous year.

Discussion turned to the cost to produce units of milk and the impact it would have on retail prices. Mr. Wilkes presented information based on findings from the cost studies alone, and with forecasted pricing factors included that were not available when the initial cost studies were performed in March. The most notable adjustment was increased labor costs associated with wage changes after the sample period. Inclusion of these factors results in an increase in costs between \$0.07 and \$0.10 per gallon of milk. Mr. Kerr asked for a motion to accept the costs to produce with inclusion of pricing factors for 2024. Mr. Craun motioned, and Ms. Kerr seconded the motion.
