The Board was informed that House Bill 1718 and Senate Bill 1527 which created a waiver of examination period for esthetician and master esthetician licenses became effective March 23, 2009, and will be effective until July 31, 2009. The Board was provided the memorandum and application that were to be sent by mail and e-mail in accordance with the notification clause in the bill.
