The Board took under consideration § 54.1-201.1 of the Code of Virginia. The Board was informed that the 2010 General Assembly passed Senate Bill 474 and House Bill 792 which amended the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 54.1-201.1, relating to Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation; issuance of temporary licenses and certifications. The Board determined that since the Board currently has regulations which provide for the issuance of temporary permits and apprentice licenses, temporary permits will not be issued under the authority of Section 54.1-201.1.

§ 54.1-201.1 of the Code of Virginia – Temporary Permit

Concerning the regulations pertaining to the qualifications for instructor certification, Mr. Ferguson introduced to the Board an issue pertaining to the determination of postsecondary educational level training.

Interpretation of Regulation – Postsecondary Education

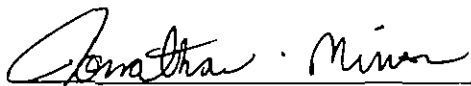
Mr. Jack suggested that before taking action the Board should confer with their assigned legal counsel regarding the legal interpretation of regulations. The Board did not take any action on this issue.

Mr. Ferguson announced that Ms. Williams had accepted the position of Examinations Manager in the DPOR Examinations section.

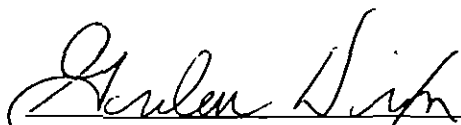
