The Training Program Review Committee of the Common Interest Community Board met on Wednesday, March 21, 2012, at the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR), 9960 Mayland Drive, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Board Room 4, Richmond, Virginia 23233.

Mr. Perry provided the Committee members with a brief overview of Overview of the training program review process to date.

Training Programs and Approval Process

Mr. Perry reviewed with the Committee changes to the CIC Manager New Training Regulations relating to the new training requirements for certified Program Approval principal or supervisory employees of Common Interest Community Application and

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Managers that became effective March 1, 2012. As a requirement for Regulations renewal of their certificates, these individuals must complete a Boardapproved Virginia common interest community law and regulation training program, as well as a Board-approved fair housing training program that encompasses Virginia fair housing laws related to management of common interest communities.

The new CIC Manager Regulations also provide an alternative method for **Comprehensive** licensure for CIC Managers whose qualifying individual has not completed a Board-approved training program. Upon receipt and review Equivalency by staff of a CIC Manager Application containing a Comprehensive Training Program Equivalency Form, the application will be forwarded to the three common interest community manager representatives on the Board for independent review and recommendation.

Training Program

Following the review of the new training requirements and applications, Recommendations the Committee, as suggested by Ms. Ferranti, made the following recommendations for requirements to both a Common Interest Community Law and Regulation Training Program and a Fair Housing Training Program for the Board's consideration:

- Training should provide samples of recent case law relating to common interest communities.
- Training should review changes to the Code of Virginia relating to common interest communities.
- Training should review changes to Virginia Regulations relating to common interest communities.

Ms. Coerse thanked the Committee members for their participation and March 22, 2012 input.

Ms. Henshaw said that the Committee's recommendations will be presented at the March 22, 2012 Board meeting. The next Committee meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, June 6 at 1:00 p.m. if any applications are received.
