Finding a quorum of the Board present, Ms. Trigiani, Chair, called the <u>Call to Order</u> meeting to order at 9:37 a.m.

Ms. Henshaw advised the Board of amendments to the agenda. Ms. Overholt moved to approve the agenda as amended. Ms. Johnson seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Johnson, Kacani, Orlando, Overholt, Rhodes, Sterling, Trigiani, Waddell, and Watts.

December 1, 2016, Board meeting. Mr. Orlando moved to approve the minutes as amended. Mr. Watts seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Johnson, Kacani, Orlando, Overholt, Rhodes, Sterling, Trigiani, Waddell, and Watts.

Ms. Henshaw introduced to the Board staff member Lisa Robinson, who was recently named Licensing Operations Administrator.

Introduction of Staff

Ms. Henshaw also introduced Jessica Eldridge, Presiding Officer in the Post-Adjudication and Licensing Section.

Mr. Robert Sledzaus, resident of Reston, VA, was present to address the Board. Mr. Sledzaus asked the Board to consider current language in the Property Owners' Association (POA) Disclosure Packet Notice stating that home purchasers are bound by all association decisions of its board of directors, as well as the governing documents of the association. Mr. Sledzaus stated that associations and their respective boards should be bound by state statutes and the Virginia Nonstock Corporation Act, and therefore feels that the referenced statement is misleading. Mr. Sledzaus asked the Board to consider amending the POA Disclosure Packet Notice as such.

Public Comment Period

Mr. Orlando recused himself from the meeting for the discussions and deliberations regarding File Number 2015-02873.

Recusal of Board Member

Justin Bell, Assistant Attorney General with the Office of the Attorney General, introduced himself to the Board and recused himself from the discussion of File Number 2015-02873.

Recusal of Board Counsel

In the matter of File Number 2015-02873, RH1 Management, LLC, the Board members reviewed the record which consisted of the Report of Findings, transcript and exhibits from the Informal Fact-Finding and the Presiding Officer's Summary Recommendation. Ms. Kacani moved to accept the Presiding Officer's recommendation and find no violation of Board Regulation 18VAC 48-50-190.17. Mr. Watts seconded the motion. After discussion, the motion to accept the Presiding Officer's Summary Recommendation and find no violation was approved by: Johnson, Kacani, Overholt, Rhodes, Sterling, Trigiani, and Watts. Ms. Waddell voted in opposition to the motion. The motion was passed by majority vote.

Ms. Kacani recused herself from the meeting for the discussions and Recusal of Board deliberations regarding File Number 2017-01345.

In the matter of File Number 2017-01345, Robert Allen Garrett, the Board members reviewed the record which consisted of the application file, transcript, and exhibits from the Informal Fact-Finding Conference, and the Presiding Officer's Summary and Recommendation. noted that a correction was needed to the title of the certificate in the Summary and Recommendation, and recommended that the title of the certificate be corrected in three places. Mr. Orlando moved to amend the Summary and Recommendation to make the noted corrections. Ms. Waddell seconded the motion which was approved by: Johnson, Orlando, Overholt, Rhodes, Sterling, Trigiani, Waddell, and Watts.

After discussion, Mr. Watts moved to accept the recommendation of the Presiding Officer and approve Mr. Garrett's application for a common interest community manager principal or supervisory employee certificate. Ms. Waddell seconded the motion which was approved by: Johnson, Orlando, Overholt, Rhodes, Sterling, Trigiani, Waddell, and Watts.

Ms. Kacani returned to the meeting.

Mr. Haughwout provided an update on the current status of the regulatory review processes for the Board's regulatory packages:

The public comment period held on amendments to public participation guidelines ended on February 22, 2017. There were no public comments received. The amendments will become effective March 13, 2017.

Executive branch review of Board-approved amendments to the Common Interest Community Ombudsman Regulations revising the timeframe for establishing a complaint process has been completed, and final regulations have been submitted for publication. A final 30-day comment period will commence on March 20, 2017, after which the regulations will become effective May 1, 2017.

The public comment period held on proposed amendments to the training program provisions of the Common Interest Community Manager Regulations ended on February 10, 2017. There were no public comments received. Mr. Haughwout advised the Board that the proposed text of the amendments would be presented to the Board for consideration later in the meeting.

Mr. Haughwout presented the Board with the proposed text of the amendments to the training program provisions of the Common Interest Community Manager Regulations. After review and discussion, Mr. Orlando moved to adopt the proposed amendments to the Common Interest Community Manager Regulations, and authorize staff to file the final regulations for executive branch review. Ms. Overholt seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Johnson, Kacani, Orlando, Overholt, Rhodes, Sterling, Trigiani, Waddell, and Watts.

Mr. Haughwout advised the Board that the temporary reduction in annual association fees to \$10.00, regardless of the number of lots or units, will expire on June 30, 2017. Mr. Haughwout asked the Board to consider extending the temporary reduction in fees to June 30, 2018, as the temporary reduction has not lowered the excess cash balance sufficiently to come into compliance with the Callahan Act. In addition, Mr. Haughwout asked the Board to consider extending the same temporary fee reduction to initial association registration application fees. After discussion, Mr. Sterling moved to authorize staff to proceed with filing an exempt action to extend the temporary fee reduction until June 30, 2018 for association renewals, and authorize a temporary fee reduction for initial association registration applications to \$10.00. regardless of number of lots or units, until June 30, 2018. Ms. Johnson seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Johnson, Kacani, Orlando, Overholt, Rhodes, Sterling, Trigiani, Waddell, and Watts.

Ms. Henshaw asked the Board to consider a provision of regulation 18VAC 48-60-20 of the CIC Management Information Fund Regulations which states that the annual report filed with the Board by an association may be a copy of the same annual report required to be filed with the State Corporation Commission. Because the Board requires information that differs from the State Corporation Commission requirements, Ms. Henshaw asked the Board to consider removing this provision. After discussion, Ms. Henshaw asked the Board to determine if a full review of the CIC Management Information Fund Regulations is necessary. Mr. Watts moved to authorize staff to file a NOIRA for a full review of the CIC Management Information Fund Regulations. Mr. Orlando seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Johnson, Kacani, Orlando, Overholt, Rhodes, Sterling, Trigiani, Waddell, and Watts.

Mr. Haughwout asked the Board to consider the development of a standard form to be used by time-shares and time-share resellers when providing bond and/or letter of credit information for registration purposes. Mr. Haughwout provided the Board with an example of similar forms currently used for condominium registrations. After discussion, the Board agreed by consensus to authorize staff to develop a bond/letter of credit form to be used for time-share and reseller registrations. Staff will present the form to the Board for review and approval at its June 8, 2017 meeting.
