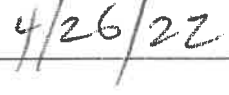

ADJOURNMENT: The Committee adjourned at 2:16 p.m.

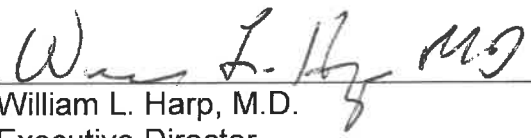
