The Chair noted that the time was 9:10 a.m. and Dr. Otchere-Boateng was noticed to appear before the Committee at 9:00

a.m. and was not present.

RULING:

Upon a motion by Dr. Hutchens, and duly seconded by Dr. Rathmann, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Otchere-Boateng. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Wood attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

RECONVENE:

Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and announced its decision

DECISION:

Upon a motion by Dr. Hutchens, and duly seconded by Dr. Rathmann, the Committee made certain findings of fact and conclusions of law and voted to issue Dr. Otchere-Boateng a reprimand.

VOTE:

The vote was unanimous.

ADJOURNMENT:

The Committee adjourned at 9:33 a.m.

As provided by law this decision shall become a Final Order thirty (30) days after service of such Order on Dr. Otchere-Boateng, unless a written request to the Board for a formal hearing on the allegations made against him is received from Dr. Otchere-Boateng, within such time. If service of the Order is made by mail three (3) additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of the Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.
