Ms. Benson moved that the Committee convene a closed meeting pursuant to Section 2.2-3711(A)(28) of the *Code of Virginia* for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Pinsker regarding the allegations outlined in the Notice of Hearing. Additionally, Ms. Benson moved that Ms. Brown, Mr. Opper and Ms. Williams attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting is deemed necessary, and their presence will aid the Committee in its deliberations.

The motion was seconded and carried.

The Committee reconvened in open session.

Ms. Benson moved that the Informal Conference Committee certify that it heard,

discussed or considered only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom on Information Act and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the Closed Meeting was convened. The motion was seconded and carried.

ACTION:

The committee made no finding of fact or conclusion of law as it did not find clear and convincing evidence to support the allegation. The allegation was dismissed.

The motion was seconded and carried.
