2022 Appropriation Act: PRTF/ARTS requirements

Item 304(X)

- Providers are required to submit cost reports as part of rebasing
 - Applies to: PRTFs and qualifying ARTS providers
 - New residential psychiatric facilities
 - Proforma cost report used to set an initial per diem rate for up to two years
 - Out of state providers with more than 1,500 Virginia Medicaid paid days
- Separate statewide weighted average per diems for PRTFs and ARTS
- Providers that do not submit cost reports receive a rate set at 75% of the ceiling

PRTF Reimbursement Regulations

12VAC30-70-417. Reimbursement for Inpatient Psychiatric Services in Residential Treatment Facilities (Level C) under EPSDT

- Reimbursement for inpatient psychiatric services is based on a per diem rate
 - Rate is determined by provider-submitted information
- Enrolled PRTFs shall submit cost reports as required by DMAS
 - October 21, 2022: DMAS issued notice to PRTFs to submit cost reports by December 30, 2022
 - December 30, 2022: 15 out of 30 PRTFs submitted cost reports
 - May 1, 2023: 22 out of 30 PRTFs submitted cost reports
 - 8 PRTFs did not submit cost reports and will receive a rate equal to 75% of the PRTF ceiling

ARTS Provider Reimbursement Regulations

12VAC30-70-418. Reimbursement for Residential and Inpatient Substance Use Treatment Services

- Reimbursement for services provided in an appropriately licensed residential setting is based on a per diem rate
 - Rate is determined based on provider-submitted information
- Enrolled ARTS providers shall submit cost reports as required by DMAS
 - October 21, 2022: DMAS issued notice to ARTS providers to submit cost reports by December 30, 2022
 - December 30, 2022: 5 out of 27 ARTS providers submitted cost reports
 - May 1, 2023: 20 out of 27 ARTS providers submitted cost reports
 - 7 ARTS providers did not submit cost reports and will receive a rate equal to 75% of the ARTS ceiling

Data Sources

- Provider-submitted cost reports for the time period July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022
- Number of bed-days identified through the DMAS Enterprise Data Warehouse System
 - Used for comparison purposes

Assumptions

- Each facility accurately reported all information on their cost report submissions
- Out-of-state facilities that submitted cost reports should be included in the ceiling calculations
- One combined cost per day is calculated for each of the following
 - PRTF
 - ARTS ASAM Level 3.3
 - ARTS ASAM Level 3.5
 - ARTS ASAM Level 3.7

Rate Calculation Process

- Separate data submitted from PRTFs and ARTS providers
- $(\text{Medicaid Bed-Days} * \text{Cost Per Day}) / \text{Total Medicaid Bed-Days}$
 - Uses data submitted by providers on cost reports
- Two rates are identified
 1. Statewide weighted average cost per day
 2. Facility-specific cost per day

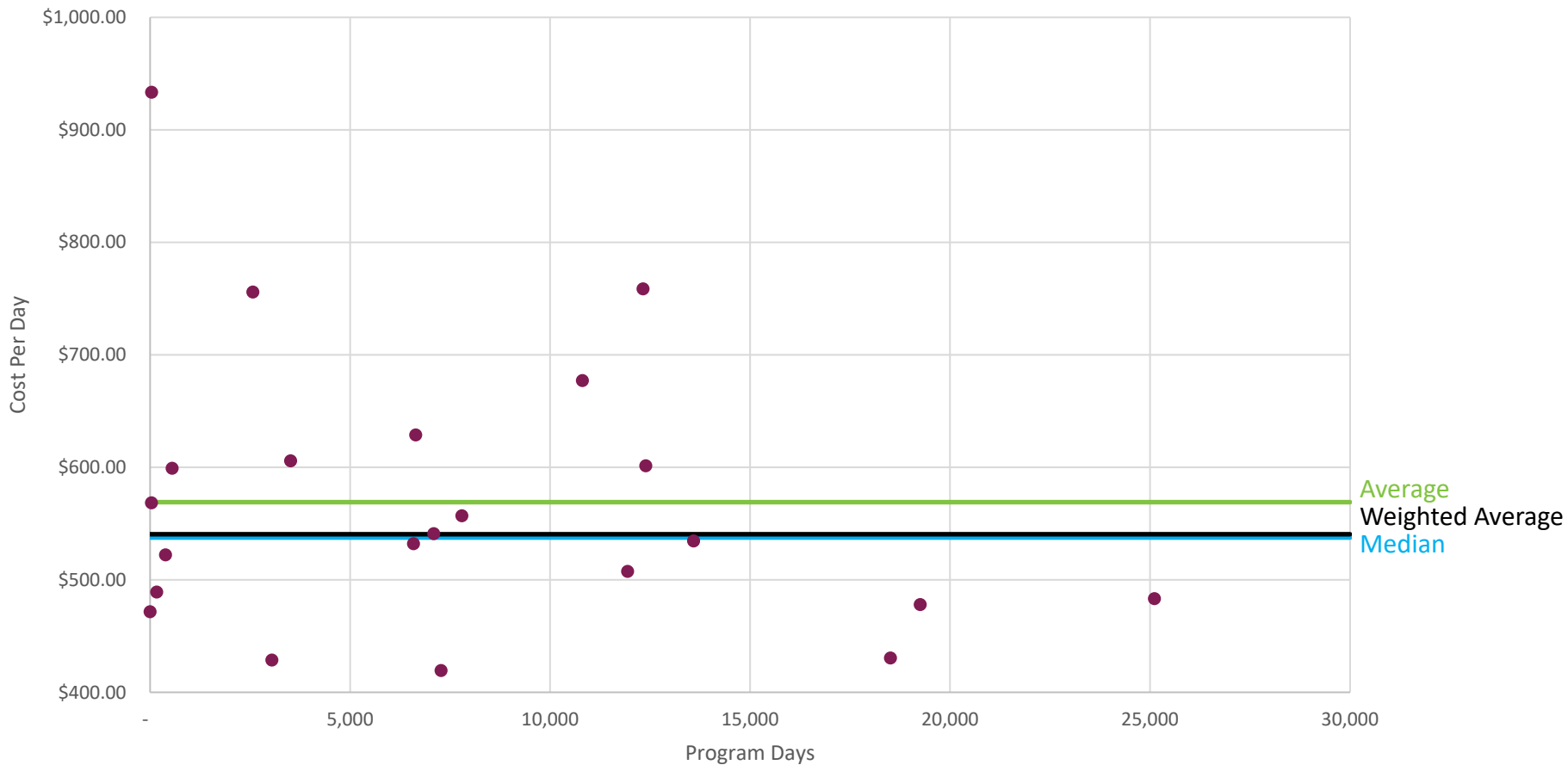
Rate Calculation Process

- Example: Statewide weighted average cost per day: \$500

Facility	Cost Report Per Diem	Final Assigned Rate
PRTF 1	\$450	\$450
PRTF 2	\$650	\$500
PRTF 3	Did not submit	\$375

PRTF Calculated Rates

Statewide Weighted Average Ceiling = **\$540.51**

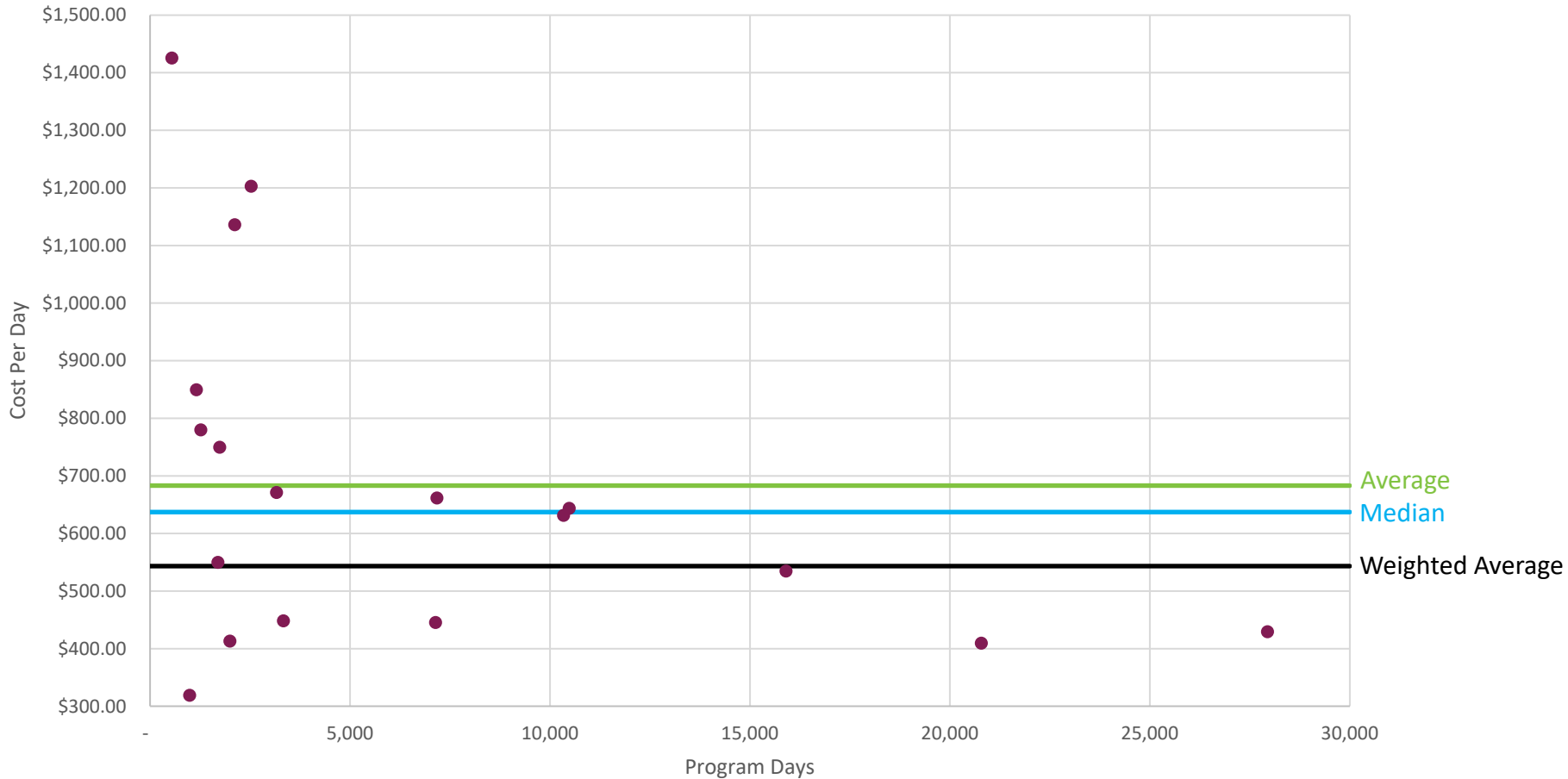

Summary

- New statewide ceilings effective July 1, 2023
 - PRTF: \$540.51
 - ARTS: \$543.42
- Rate for facilities that **did not submit** cost reports effective July 1, 2023
 - PRTF: \$405.38
 - ARTS: \$407.57
- Current rates will be the base rates from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2026
 - Base rates will be inflated annually
