**Resilience Definition**

Resilience or resiliency is the capability of a transportation project or strategy to anticipate, prepare for, respond to, or recover from significant multi hazard threats with minimum damage and disruption to the transportation network.

**Needs Statement**

Virginia's transportation network is being subjected to changing conditions currently and in the future that threaten its ability to safely and efficiently move people and goods. To date, one of the most threatening conditions include, recurrent flooding and other water inundation related impacts in its coastal and inland areas of the state. As part of the Commonwealth's resiliency planning, the transportation sector must develop specific strategies to anticipate, prepare and mitigate for events that put the transportation network at risk for disruption and deterioration.
