### Public Hearing on the Proposed Regulations March 24, 2004

This is a public hearing held at the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation, 3600 W. Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia. This hearing is being held pursuant to §2.2- 4007 of the Administrative Process Act of the Code of Virginia for the purpose of receiving public comment on the Board's proposed regulations published in the Virginia Register on Monday, February 9, 2004.

#### Rules for this Hearing

Comments will be received from any member of the public and initial comments will be limited to a maximum of 5 minutes depending on the number of individuals who wish to speak. If you have not signed up to speak and you wish to give testimony today, please sign your name on the sign up sheet at this time.

Anyone may speak in rebuttal to the comments of another speaker and those comments will also be limited in the amount of time they may speak. I will call for rebuttal comments when all speakers on the list have finished.

Board members may ask speakers questions or request clarification of statements. However, this is **not** the proper forum for questions to the Board. If you have a question for the Board, please forward it in writing, to the Board.

Any speaker who wishes to provide a written statement in addition to his oral testimony, or in lieu of oral testimony, may do so until April 9, 2004.
