Public Comment Period

Robby Dawson – NFPA Certification Program, provided the Committee a comparison sheet, requesting consideration for Fire Sprinkler Inspectors for equivalency with NICET Level III. Mr. Dawson, stated he would be presenting this information to the Board under new business.

Timothy "Hooper" Loscomb, with Virginia AFSA, & Eagle Fire informed the Board the Fire Sprinkler Association they are still waiting for the National Fire Sprinkler Association to complete their language interpretation of the Fire Sprinkler Regulation, at which time the Fire Sprinkler Association will submit a letter of recommendation to the Board. The largest concern is in regards to issues brought up involving Fire Marshals and localities conducting inspections. Mr. Loscomb is in favor of the Board's consideration of the NFPA Certification Program to be equivalent to the NICET Level III certification for Fire Sprinkler Inspectors'

George Wagner, Virginia Fire Sprinkler Association is in favor of the Board's consideration of the NFPA Certification Program to be equivalent to the NICET Level III certification for Fire Sprinkler Inspectors'.

Public Comment handout from John Doe

The ineptness of the Virginia Board For Contractors needs to be addressed.

Why didn't the board for contractors, with all it's supposed regulation and policing of contractors and making sure that they're responsible for those they hire, take action to allow alternatives when the exam vendor that it was responsible for, shut down because of Covid? Instead the board just told people to contact the exam vendor as if that vendor was the one with the ultimate responsibility. Is this how the board expects contractors to deal with their employees and subcontractors when a customer complains? If not then why is there a different standard for the board? The board was authorized to waive regulations and they should have allowed out-of-state companies with similar licenses is at least temporary license to operate instead of telling people to contact their exam vendor. Now, the board is changing back and forth at its meetings, what license is required for a particular type of contracting. This is a weighty thing, and not something members should come and vote back and forth on at meetings.

Recently the board finally announced action to allow time and materials contracting which is commonly done throughout the industry and has been done this way for years in certain types of cases. The board believes that no administrative oversight of this decision is required and it can make this change on a

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whim at its quarterly board meetings even though if it was competent it should've made this change years ago. Recently, it was mentioned at a meeting, that attendees of the remedial education programs remarked that they wish that would have been offered the course pre-licensure because of the number of things they had not been made aware of. Pathetically, the boards only response was a member saying that offering this to all contractors would be too expensive. It is unthinkable that the board would be bringing action against people, and those people expose that there's a problem with pre-license education, and the board administrator (while still being content to continue his enforcement) are unwilling to address the problem with people making errors in large part due to ignorance. The board has a responsibility to promulgate the rules (not just enforce them) and this is evidence of failure of that mission. This writer has taken the board approved 8 hour contractor license business class and finds it to be woefully inadequate and useless. It's shameful that the board has approved this, then been told by contractors who have gotten into trouble that it's inadequate, and only mentioned they can't afford to do better. If the board can't afford to do its job properly it may be better that it just not do it at all. Why doesn't the board at least as a starting point video record some of its training and put it online for free, so that those who wish to have it could review it before they make mistakes? This would at least give companies an opportunity to not only have their qualified people but their regular employees be more familiar with the rules that they must operate under. I think the board needs a serious review of its practices.

Chairman Hux, addressed the Board in comment to John Doe. Mr. Hux thanked the Board for all its time and effort that goes into preparing for these meetings.

Mr. Olson, Executive Director informed the Board that Mr. Doe may have brought up some valid points, although, the costs of hosting a Pre-License Course for the Board for Contractors is not the only factor to consider. Mr. Olson recommended sending this to the Committee to determine if the concerns of John Doe warrant action.

With no one else wishing to come forward, Chairman Hux closed the Public Comment section of the meeting.
