



4 Staff members may ask speakers questions or
5 to clarify statements. However, this is not the proper
6 forum for questions of the Board. If you have a
7 question for the Board, please forward them in writing
8 to the Board.

9 Any speaker who wishes to provide a written
10 statement in addition to his oral testimony, or in lieu
11 of oral testimony, may do so until August 1, 2025.


