#### CEMETERY BOARD MEETING

### **MINUTES**

June 6, 2007

The Cemetery Board met on June 6, 2007, at the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR), 3600 West Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia. The following members were present:

No representative from the Office of the Attorney General was present at the meeting.

Chairman Bell called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM

Call to Order

William A. Tucker, a member of the Board for Professional and Public Comment Occupational Regulation, was present to observe the proceedings of the Board meeting. No one addressed the Board during the Public Comment period.

A motion was made by Mr. Doherty and seconded by Mr. Gleason to Agenda approve the agenda. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were Bell, Berney, Doherty, Gleason, King, and Kirsch.

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A motion was made by Ms. King and seconded by Mr. Doherty to adopt the following minutes: January 10, 2007, Board Meeting; March 15, 2007, Informal Fact-Finding Conference; May 8, 2007, Informal Fact-Finding Conference; and May 10, 2007 Informal Fact-Finding Conference. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were Bell, Berney, Doherty, Gleason, King, and Kirsch.

File Number 2006-04066, Star City Memorial Sales Subsidiary, Inc.

In the matter of File Number 2006-04066, Star City Memorial Sales Subsidiary, Inc., the Board reviewed the record which consisted of the Consent Order. A motion was made by Mr. Bell and seconded by Mr. Gleason to accept the Consent Order wherein Star City Memorial Sales Subsidiary, Inc. admits to violations of §54.1-2328 (2 violations), of the Code of Virginia (Count 1), and §54.1-2326 (4 violations) (Count 2), of the Code of Virginia, and 18 VAC 47-20-190.13 (4 violations) (Count 3) of the Board's 2000 regulations and agrees to a monetary penalty of \$500.00 for each violation contained in Count 1, \$500.00 for each violation contained in Count 2, and \$1,500.00 for each violation contained in Count 3 and agrees to pay \$150.00 in Board costs for a total of \$9,150.00. Additionally, Star City Memorial Sales Subsidiary, Inc. agrees to refund \$3,378.00 to the Hansen family for Violation 1 of Count 3 within 30 days of the Board's acceptance of this order, and providing the Board with proof of payment of the refund. Upon receipt of proof of payment to the Hansen family, Star City Memorial Sales Subsidiary, Inc. agrees to the \$1,500.00 monetary penalty for Violation 1 of Count 3 and the Board shall waive impostition of the following monetary penalties: Count 1 (\$1,000.00), Count 2 (\$2,000.00) and Count 3 (Violation 2, 3 and 4 -  $$1,500.00 \times 3 = $4,500.00$ ). If Star City Memorial Sales Subsidiary, Inc. fails to comply with these conditions, then the full monetary penalty will be automatically imposed. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were Bell, Berney, Gleason, and King.

As the reviewing Board member Mr. Doherty did not participate in the discussion or votes related to this matter. Due to a possible conflict of interest, Mr. Kirsch recused himself from voting in this matter.

In the matter of File Number 2007-01509, SCI Virginia Funeral Services, Inc., the Board reviewed the record which consisted of the Consent Order A motion was made by Ms. Berney and seconded by Ms. King to accept the Consent Order wherein SCI Virginia Funeral Services, Inc. admits to a violation of \$54.1-2339 of the Code of Virginia and agrees to a monetary penalty of \$500.00 for the violation contained in Count 1, and agrees to pay \$150.00 in Board costs for a

SCI Virginia Funeral Services, Inc. completed total of \$650.00. construction of the mausoleum on December 27, 2006, failing to start construction of the mausoleum within four (4) years of the date of the first sale and did not complete construction within five (5) years after the date of the first such sale. Therefore, SCI agrees to give refunds to any preneed customer who requests their money back for this mausoleum. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were Bell, Berney, Gleason, King, and Kirsch.

As the reviewing Board member Mr. Doherty did not participate in the discussion or votes related to this matter.

In the matter of File Number 2007-03364, Misty Tabor, the Board reviewed the record which consisted of the application file, transcript Misty Tabor and exhibits, and the Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference of the presiding officer. Ms. Tabor, the applicant, was present and addressed the Board. A motion was made by Mr. Gleason and seconded by Mr. Kirsch to accept the recommendation contained in the Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference and, after consideration of the criteria contained in § 54.1-204.B of the Code of Virginia, approve Ms. Tabor's application for a cemetery sales personnel registration. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were Berney. Doherty, Gleason, King, and Kırsch.

Due to a possible conflict of interest, Mr. Bell recused himself from voting in this matter.

In the matters of File Number 2007-04147, Brian Hensley, the Board File Number 2007-04147, reviewed the record which consisted of the application file, transcript Brian Hensley and exhibits, and the Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference of the presiding officer Mr. Hensley, the applicant, was present and addressed the Board. A motion was made by Ms. Berney and seconded by Ms. King to accept the recommendation contained in the Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference and, after consideration of the criteria contained in § 54.1-204.B of the Code of Virginia, approve Mr. Hensley's application for a cemetery sales personnel registration. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were Bell, Berney. Doherty, Gleason, King, and Kirsch.

In the matter of File Number 2007-04443, Heritage Family File Number 2007-04443, Management, Inc., the Board reviewed the record which consisted of Heritage Family the application file, transcript and exhibits, and the Summary of the Management, Inc. Informal Fact-Finding Conference of the presiding Board member. A

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motion was made by Mr. Bell and seconded by Mr. Kirsch to accept the recommendation as written and approve Heritage Family Management, LLC as the trustee for Heritage Family Cemetery, Inc. provided that any material change in management or ownership is reported to the Board within thirty days. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were Bell, Berney, Doherty, Gleason, King, and Kirsch.

In the matters of File Number 2007-04529, Benjamin Hale, the Board reviewed the record which consisted of the application file, transcript and exhibits, and the Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference of the presiding officer. A motion was made by Ms. Berney and seconded by Mr. Gleason to accept the recommendation contained in the Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference and, after consideration of the criteria contained in § 54.1-204.B of the Code of Virginia, approve Mr. Hale's application for a cemetery sales personnel registration. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were Bell, Berney, Doherty, Gleason, King, and Kirsch.

File Number 2007-04529, Benjamin Hale

Christine Martine updated the Board on the status of the Regulations. Regulations No action was taken by the Board.

Mr. Bell addressed the Board concerning DUI Convictions on license New Business applications. A motion was made by Mr. Doherty and seconded by Mr. Gleason to give staff the authority to issue licenses that have one misdemeanor DUI conviction noted. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were Bell, Berney, Doherty, Gleason, King, and Kirsch.

Mr. Doherty addressed the Board concerning the 8 hour compliance agent training course and the possibility of reducing the amount of hours required. The Board agreed without dissent to review this information during the next regulatory review process.

Mr. Doherty addressed the Board concerning the requirement that cemetery companies provide Annual Trust Fund Reports with a CPA Audit. The Board agreed without dissent to defer this item to its next scheduled Board meeting.

Herb Nichols addressed the Board concerning the use of the term "Community Cemetery". Mr. Nichols suggested that the Board determine a standard definition of "Community Cemetery" for future use by staff members to aid in the determination of exempt status. In regards to the use of the term "Community Cemetery", Mr. Nichols

discussed a cemetery that is currently considering itself as a "Community Cemetery". A motion was made by Mr. Bell and seconded by Ms. King to have staff draft a letter from the Board to the Circuit Court in regards to the cemetery in question. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were Bell, Berney, Doherty, Gleason, King, and Kirsch.
