The Board was informed that the 2010 General Assembly Code of Virginia passed Senate Bill 474 and House Bill 792 which amended the Code of Temporary Permit Virginia by adding a section numbered 54.1-201.1, relating to Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation; issuance of temporary licenses and certifications. The Board determined that since the Board currently has regulations which provide for the issuance of temporary permits and apprentice licenses, temporary permits will not be issued under the authority of Section 54.1-201.1.
