REGULATORY ACTION AND BOARD GUIDANCE

Mr. Kirschner reported to the Board on the progress of the Master Barber Regulations and provided an overview of the creation of the Master Barber license. He reported that the proposed regulations have been approved by the Governor and that the next phase is the public comment period that will take place from February 4 through March 6, 2019.

Report on Current Regulatory Actions

Mr. Kirschner also advised the Board that the review of the Tattoo and Body Piercing Regulations is still pending. A meeting of the Tattoo and Body Piercing Regulations Review Committee will be scheduled for March 11, 2019, immediately following the full Board meeting.

Also pending is the action to remove the term "tuberculocidal" from the regulations, approved by the Board at its November 19, 2018 meeting.

Mr. Kirschner advised the Board that the typographical corrections it had recommended to the Esthetician and Master Esthetician Regulations have been approved and were effective January 1, 2019.

Mr. Kirschner provided the Board with two proposed options to consider for a Guidance Document that would interpret if Regulation 18 VAC 41-20-200.3.a. includes instructor programs when it allows cosmetology instructors to teach


nail and wax programs. The Board discussed whether the regulations allow cosmetology instructors to teach nail and wax instructor programs.


