#### MINUTES OF MEETING

The Board for Opticians met on Friday, December 9, 2011, 9:30 a.m., at the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR), 9960 Mayland Drive, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Board Room 3, Richmond, Virginia 23233.

Ms. Taylor determined there was a quorum and called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m.

Call to Order

Mr. Ferguson introduced several additions to the agenda, including statistics on closed cases; the Director's Report; the Governor's Commission on Government Reform; a report from the attendees of the NCSORB annual meeting; and required Financial Disclosure Statements. Upon a motion by Mr. Flippin and seconded by Ms. Allgood, the Board voted to approve the amended agenda. The members voting 'yes' were Ms. Taylor, Ms. Allgood, and Mr. Flippin. There were no negative votes. The motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Agenda

Ms. Taylor asked for public comment. There was no public comment.

**Public Comment** 

Upon a motion by Mr. Flippin and seconded by Ms. Allgood, the Board

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voted to approve the minutes of the Board for Opticians August 19, 2011 board meeting and the November 14, 2011, Informal Fact Finding Conference.

The members voting 'yes' were Ms. Taylor, Ms. Allgood, and Mr. Flippin. There were no negative votes. The motion passed unanimously.

In the matter of File Number 2012-01063, Andrea Voncille Edwards, the Board reviewed the record which consisted of the application file, transcript, exhibits, and the Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference. Andrea Voncille Edwards appeared at the meeting in person and addressed the Board.

Upon a motion by Mr. Flippin and seconded by Ms. Allgood, the Board voted to accept the recommendation in the Summary of the Informal Fact-Finding Conference and approve Andrea Voncille Edwards' application for an Optician license.

The members voting 'yes' were Ms. Taylor, Ms. Allgood, and Mr. Flippin. There were no negative votes. The motion passed unanimously.

The Board reviewed its examination statistics for informational purposes.

At its August 19, 2011 meeting, the Board voted to investigate the availability of computer based Optician practical examinations. Ms. Sweet presented a report of her investigation. On August 24, 2011 an inquiry about the availability of computer-based Optician practical exams was posted on the Council on Licensure, Enforcement and Regulation (CLEAR) Discussion Forum. No comments were received. On September 21, 2011, an inquiry was sent to five examination vendors about the availability of computer-based Optician practical exams through each company. The five companies responded that they do not offer a computer-based Optician practical examination. Ms. Sweet recommended to the Board that it can pursue a sole source contract with the Joint Commission on Allied Health Personnel in Ophthalmology (JCAHOP) and the National Committee of State Opticianry Regulatory Boards (NCSORB) as the only vendor with a computer-based Optician practical examination.

Upon a motion by Mr. Flippin and seconded by Ms. Allgood, the Board voted to adopt Ms. Sweet's recommendation and to procure the computer-based Optician practical examination.

The members voting 'yes' were Ms. Taylor, Ms. Allgood, and Mr.

Flippin. There were no negative votes. The motion passed unanimously.

The members voting 'yes' were Ms. Taylor, Ms. Allgood, and Mr. Flippin. There were no negative votes. The motion passed unanimously.

Pertaining to the Opticians Regulations, no public comment was received.

Upon a motion by Mr. Flippin and seconded by Ms. Allgood, the Board voted to retain the Opticians Regulations as is.

The members voting 'yes' were Ms. Taylor, Ms. Allgood, and Mr. Flippin. There were no negative votes. The motion passed unanimously

Mr. Dixon announced that a Director's Report will become a part of all DPOR Board meetings going forward. During his report, Mr. Dixon presented an overview of the Governor's Commission on Government Reform and Restructuring and how it may impact the Board for Opticians and other boards, including the proposed combining of the Board for Opticians and the Board for Hearing Aid Specialists, and a reduction of out-of-state travel.
