Loraine Schroeder, investigator, read a statement from the complainant's representative. Glenn S. Reynolds, attorney for the respondents, was present and addressed the Board. A motion was made by Mr. Crouse and seconded by Ms. Wilson to find no reasonable cause that the respondents discriminated against the complainant by refusing to rent or otherwise making housing unavailable, discriminatory terms and conditions and/or making a discriminatory statement based on disability. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were: Bennett, Crouse, Howard, Melton, Northup, Reisinger, Schaberg and Wilson.

In the matter of FHB File Number 2017-00029, Susana Pellegrino and Christopher Pellegrino v. Mark A. Stephens, Ltd., the Board reviewed the record which consisted of the Final Investigative Report and Case Analysis. A motion was made by Ms. Wilson and seconded by Mr. Schaberg to find no reasonable cause that the respondent discriminated against the complainants by refusing to rent or otherwise making housing unavailable, based on national origin.
