A motion was made by Mr. Crouse and seconded by Ms. Bennett to find no reasonable cause that the respondents discriminated against the complainant by refusing to rent or otherwise make housing unavailable, refusing to make a reasonable accommodation or by offering him different terms and conditions based on race or disability. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were: Bennett, Crouse, Murphy, Northup and Roth.

In the matter of FHB File Number 2019-01522, Ramon Ibarra v. Rick Titus, ARCAP, LC, and Greenleigh MHC, LLC, the Board reviewed the record which consisted of the Final Investigative Report, and Case Analysis. Jeffrey Marks, attorney for the respondents, was present and addressed the Board. A motion was made by Ms. Bennett and seconded by Mr. Crouse to find no reasonable cause that the respondents discriminated against the complainant by offering discriminatory terms and conditions of rental based upon national origin. A motion was made by Mr. Crouse and seconded by Ms. Roth to find no reasonable cause that the respondents discriminated against the complainant by refusing to make a reasonable accommodation or otherwise make housing unavailable based on disability. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were: Bennett, Crouse, Murphy, Northup and Roth.

FHB File Number 2019-01523, Valerie Lewis v. Brett Eagle and Michael Lekhraj

In the matter of FHB File Number 2019-00044, Kathy Iliff-Darnell v. Mintbrook Senior Apartments LLC, JDC Management of Virginia, LLC, Thomas F. Kistner, and Ana Montoya, the Board reviewed the record which consisted of the Final Investigative Report, and Case Analysis. Joseph Greener, attorney for the respondents, was present and addressed the Board. A motion was made by Ms. Roth and seconded by Ms. Crouse to find no reasonable cause that the respondents discriminated against the complainant by imposing discriminatory terms and conditions, by refusing to rent or otherwise make housing unavailable, or by engaging in intimidation, coercion, or harassment, or by retaliation based upon sex or disability. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were: Bennett, Crouse, Murphy, Northup and Roth.

In the matter of FHB File Number 2019-00646, Elnora Delcid v. ANS Property LLC and Priscilla Price, the Board reviewed the record which consisted of the Final Investigative Report, and Case Analysis. A motion was made by Ms. Bennett and seconded by Mr. Crouse to find no reasonable cause that the respondents discriminated against the complainant by making a discriminatory statement based upon race. A motion was made by Mr. Northup and seconded by Ms. Bennett to find no reasonable cause that the respondents discriminated against the complainant by refusing to rent in terms and conditions of a rental based upon disability and/or religion. V-K Properties LLC, Saint Claire St. Villages LLC, and Sally Vent, Leasing Agent, a motion was made by Mr. Northup and seconded by Ms. Bennett to approve the terms of the conciliation agreement as agreed to by the parties. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "Yes" were: Bennett, Crouse, Murphy, Northup and Roth.
