Director Dixon thanked Capt. Cofer for his presentation and welcomed the Gordon Dixon, Board and offered congratulations to Ms. Miles on her additional Director's Report appointment as a member of the Board of Visitors at Christopher Newport University.

In the Director's Report, Mr. Dixon explained the Department has submitted a revised strategic plan to coincide with the Governor's initiatives, mainly, job creation. Key measures of this are how to manage dollars; the speed and efficiency of processing licenses; and effectively handling complaints.

He further discussed the Governor's Reform Commission which is addressing many issues, one of which relates to processes within DPOR: the Callahan Act which determines how and when to raise or lower fees; and streamlining (merge/eliminate) boards within DPOR and DHP.

Mr. Dixon stated that the Department has submitted its Legislative package that introduces four pieces of legislation to the Policy Office. He also explained that the EAGLES database project, originally scheduled for a 2014 completion date, is on target for completion. It was also explained that DPOR CID staff has had recent changes with the unexpected loss of one staff member and promotion of two others.

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Ms. Nosbisch presented the Branch Pilots Board Academy.
