#### MINUTES OF MEETING

The CIC Management Information Fund Regulatory Review Committee of the Common Interest Community Board (Board) met on September 27, 2018, at the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR), 9960 Mayland Drive, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Board Room 4, Richmond, Virginia 23233.

Mr. Orlando, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m.

Call to Order

Members of the Committee and Board staff introduced themselves.

Introduction of Committee Members

Mr. Orlando advised the Committee of the emergency evacuation Emergency procedures.

Evacuation Procedures

Ms. Jonas moved to approve the agenda as presented. Mr. Mulhare seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Jonas, Mulhare, Orlando, Rhodes, and Rogers.

Approval of Agenda

Cynthia Gale was present to address the Committee. Ms. Gale stated that she has attended several educational events that were heavily attended by members of self-managed associations. Ms. Gale asked the **Public Comment** Period

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Committee to recommend to the Board that the remaining interest accrued on the moneys in the CIC Management Information Fund be used to fund education programs for common interest communities as described in § 55-530.D. of the Code of Virginia. Ms. Gale also suggested that improvements be made to the license lookup feature on the DPOR website.

Ms. Henshaw presented the Committee with an overview of the regulatory review process and advised the Committee's recommended amendments to the CIC Management Information Fund Regulations will be presented to the Board for review at its November 29, 2018, Board meeting.

The Committee was provided with current and previous versions of applicable laws and regulations, as well as Board association fees data for reference.

The Committee reviewed draft text of proposed amendments to the CIC Management Information Regulations in conjunction with comments received in 2017 from Board members.

The Committee recessed from 11:25 a.m. to 12:03 p.m.

The Committee considered the following during its review of the draft regulations:

- a 2006 study conducted by the Real Estate Board which recommended the model for the current tiered association registration fee structure in the regulations;
- the Callahan Act, and the requirement for licensing/registration fees to be within 10% of expenses;
- comments received in 2017 from Board members regarding the registration fee structure;
- submitting legislative proposals for consideration during a future General Assembly session to amend statutes governing associations to remove statutory annual payment requirements;
- definition of terms:
- House Bill 1031, which amends the statutes governing disclosure packets. HB 1031 was passed during the 2018 General Assembly session; and
- Senate Bill 328, effective on July 1, 2019, which amends the information required on the Disclosure Packet Notice.

Continue Discussion of Proposed Regulations

In addition, based on previous discussion of the fee structure in the current regulations, Mr. Waite was available to answer questions regarding the Board's current and projected financial position over the next several biennia, current registration fee structure, and analysis for anticipated registration trends. After discussion, the Committee agreed to maintain the current tiered fee structure at this time, to include the temporary flat fee.

Return of Board Member

The Committee continued review and discussion of the draft text of proposed amendments in conjunction with comments received in 2017 from Board members. Amendments were made to the draft, including:

- addition of definitions for clarification;
- deleting "size" as it relates to associations and replace with "number of lots/units subject to the declaration";
- provisions related to annual report filings and necessity to file;
   and
- language regarding statutory provisions applicable to disclosure packets and resale certificates.

After discussion, Mr. Rhodes moved to adopt the proposed draft text as amended for recommendation to the Board, subject to final review of the amended draft text by the Committee. In addition, staff will work with the Committee Chair to finalize any amendments to the draft text prior to Board review. Mr. Rogers seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Jonas, Mulhare, Orlando, Rhodes, and Rogers.

Mr. Orlando reminded the Board members to complete their conflict of interest forms and travel youchers.
