Ms. Henshaw provided the Board with examination statistics through July 6, 2017 for informational purposes.

Examination
Statistics Report

Ms. Henshaw advised the Board that ABC just completed pilot testing of the 2017 standardized examinations for waterworks and wastewater works operators, which had taken place in a limited number of localities. Reports and data from the pilot testing are expected to be forthcoming. The 2017 standardized exam is

expected to replace the current 2012 version in September 2017.

Ms. Henshaw also advised the board that the short-term onsite sewage system professionals exam vendor contract will expire at the end of this year and Requests for Proposal (RFP) for a new exam contract have been solicited. The RFP responses are currently under review. Ms. Henshaw thanked Mr. Ewing for agreeing to participate in the review process.

Discussion was held on reciprocity and the success rates of the current water works and wastewater works exam program as compared to the previous exam program.

Mr. Saunders provided an update on onsite sewage system Update on OSSP professionals CPE audits. The audits were conducted from CPE Audits February 8, 2017 to March 31, 2017, based on random selection of 5% of current licensees.

Mr. Fore recused himself from the meeting for the discussions of Recusal of Board the Education and Training Committee recommendations.

Mr. Saunders presented the Board with a training course application from Thomas W. Fore for a course titled Ethics for Water, Wastewater and Onsite Sewer System Professionals. After discussion, Ms. Pruett moved to accept the Education and Training Committee Committee's recommendation and approve the course application for a total of 0.3 training credits. Mr. Staples seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Evans, Ewing, Lentz, Pruett, Staples, and Wadkins.

Update on **Education** and Training

Mr. Fore returned to the meeting.

Ms. Henshaw provided the Board with a Memorandum addressed to the Board for Contractors requesting consideration of a change to the Board for Contractors policy wherein a Qualified Individual (QI) of a Contractor's License with a Sewage Disposal System (SDS) specialty is required to hold a Conventional or Alternative Installer License issued by the WWWOOSSP Board. Amendments to the WWWOOSSP Board regulations effective April 1, 2017, now require a master licensee to provide direct supervision of any regulated work performed by a journeyman licensee. Therefore, a journeyman installer cannot be the individual primarily responsible for the provision of onsite sewage installation services by a licensed contractor with the SDS specialty. Ms. Henshaw is asking the Board for Contractors to consider requiring the QI of a Contractor's License with the SDS specialty to hold a current Master

Ms. Henshaw asked the Board to consider allowing onsite sewage system employers to maintain a list of master licensees for the applicable license type, as well as a list of journeyman licensees for which the master licensee may provide direct supervision of regulated services. This will ensure employers are in compliance with Board regulation 18VAC 160-40-510. After discussion, Mr. Fore moved to accept the staff recommendation and authorize staff to draft a guidance document on the matter. Ms. Lentz seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Evans, Ewing, Lentz, Pruett, Staples, and Wadkins.
