The Committee agreed without dissent to recommend that the Report of the Board amend 18 VAC 160-20-90 to accept as qualifying any experience obtained by an individual while employed at a nonclassified facility that meets the standards set forth in 18 VAC 160-20-120 for Class IV, III, II and I waterworks facilities or 18 VAC 160-20-130 for Class IV, III, II and I wastewater works facilities.
