The sanctions reported by Ms. Sacksteder were that Dr. Rader was issued a reprimand and shall pay a \$3,000.00 monetary penalty.

Within 6 months from the date of entry of the Order, Dr. Rader shall successfully complete the following continuing education courses: 6 hours in the subject of diagnosis and treatment planning; 4 hours in the subject of radiographic interpretation; 3 hours in the subject of dental recordkeeping; 3 hours in the subject of oral surgery complications; 2 hours in the subject of restorative procedures of endodontically treated teeth; and 2 hours in endodontic rotary instrumentation.

Mr. Martinez de Andino moved to adopt the decision of the Committee. The motion was seconded and passed.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Upon a motion by Mr. Martinez de Andino, the minutes from the Informal Conference conducted on February 5, 2021 and March 26, 2021 were approved.
