The Formal Administrative Hearing of the Board was called to order at

ESTABLISHMENT OF A QUORUM:

With five (5) members of the Board present, a quorum was established.

David Sloan, II, FSL

DISCUSSION:

Mr. Sloan was not present at the hearing and was not represented by counsel. The Board proceeded with the hearing in Mr. Sloan's absence as the Notice of Hearing dated April 14, 2014, was mailed to his

address of record, by regular USPS first class mail and UPS Overnight Shipment mail.

Mr. Williams ruled that adequate notice was provided to Mr. Sloan.

The Board proceeded and received evidence and sworn testimony from the Commonwealth's witnesses regarding the matters as set forth in the Statement of Particulars.

CLOSED SESSION:

Upon a motion by Mr. Welch, and duly seconded by Mr. Jones, the Board voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to 2.2-3711.A(27) of the *Code of Virginia*, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of David J. Sloan, II, FSL. Additionally, Mr. Welch moved that Ms. Hahn, Ms. Currier and Ms. Barrett attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Board in its deliberations. The Board convened into closed session at 2:00 p.m.

OPEN SESSION:

Mr. Welch certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of § 2.2.-3712 of the *Code of Virginia*; Mr. Jones seconded the certification and the Board re-convened open session at 2:31 p.m.

ACTION:

Ms. Barrett read the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law. Upon a motion by Ms. Steele and duly seconded by Mr. Welch, the Board adopt the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law, as read by Ms. Barrett.

Upon a motion by Mr. Jones and duly seconded by Mr. Welch, the Board Ordered that the right of David J. Sloan, II, F.S.L. to renew or reinstate his license as a funeral service licensee is SUSPENDED for not less than two years.

It was further ORDERED that Mr. Sloan shall be assessed a monetary penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), said penalty to be paid to the Board by certified check or money order within twelve (12) months from the date the Order is entered.
