Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee reconvened in open session and announced its decision.

DECISION:

Upon a motion by Ms. Markva, and duly seconded by Dr. McAdams, the Committee made certain Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and voted to grant Mr. Crow's petition for reinstatement and to place him on indefinite probation with terms and conditions, for not less than one year.
