- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:04 a.m.

- The Committee fully discussed Dr. Smith's petition for modification of the Order entered December 15, 2014.
- CLOSED SESSION:** Upon a motion by Dr. Zahir, and duly seconded by Dr. Archer, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Smith. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Wood attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

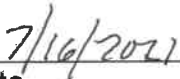
VOTE: The vote was unanimous.

ADJOURNMENT: The Committee adjourned at 11:16 a.m.

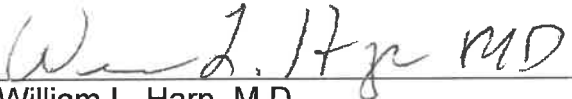

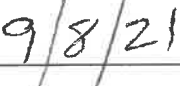

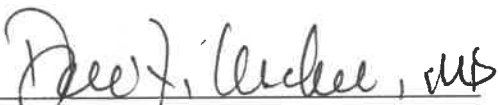

VOTE: The vote was unanimous.

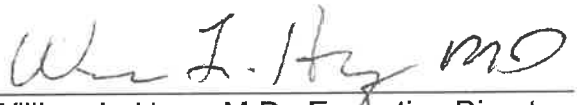
ADJOURNMENT: The Committee adjourned at 3:15 p.m.
