CALL TO ORDER: A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:16 a.m.

VOTE: The vote was unanimous.

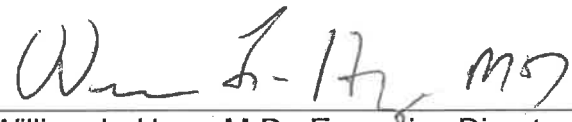
ADJOURNMENT: The Committee adjourned at 12:47 p.m.
