CALL TO ORDER: A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 10:33 a.m.

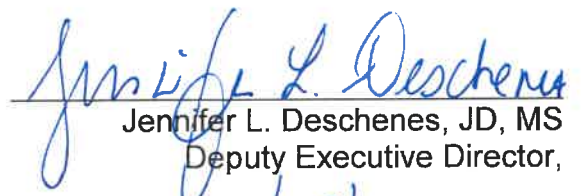

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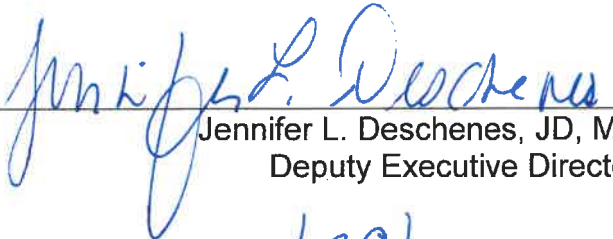
