CALL TO ORDER: A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:16 a.m.

DISCUSSION: Dr. Meadows appeared before the Committee in person in accordance with a Notice of the Board dated October 19, 2022. Dr. Meadows was not represented by counsel.

The Committee fully discussed the allegations in the Notice with Dr. Meadows.

CLOSED SESSION: Upon a motion by Dr. Apel, and duly seconded by Dr. Pradhan, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Meadows. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Wood attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

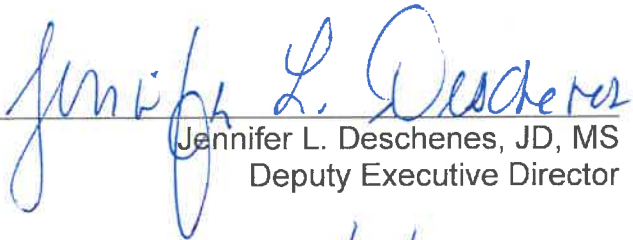
RECONVENE: Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and announced its decision.

DECISION: Upon a motion by Dr. Pradhan, and duly seconded by Dr. Apel, the Committee made certain findings of fact and conclusions of law and voted to issue Dr. Meadows a reprimand and enroll in the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program within 30 days.

VOTE: The vote was unanimous.

PRELIMINARY MATTER: The Chair noted that the time was 10:42 a.m. and Dr. Marshall was noticed to appear before the Committee at 9:00 a.m. and was not present.

Ms. Joseph advised that the Notice had been sent to Dr. Marshall's address of record with the Board by overnight and First class mail.

RULING: Based on the information provided by Ms. Joseph, the Chair determined that proper notice had been provided to Dr. Marshall, therefore, the informal conference would proceed in his absence.

DISCUSSION: Dr. Marshall did not appear before the Committee in accordance with the Board's Notice of Informal Conference dated August 8, 2022, nor was he represented at the conference by legal counsel.

The Committee fully considered the evidence before it and received information from Ms. Joseph regarding the allegations in the Notice.

CLOSED SESSION: Upon a motion by Mr. Marchese, and duly seconded by Dr. Pradhan, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Marshall. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Wood attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

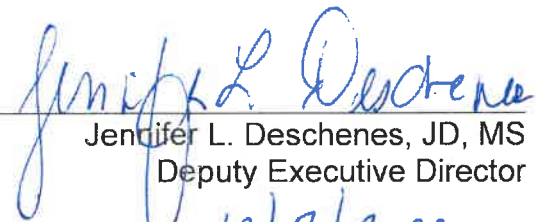
