CALL TO ORDER: A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:10 a.m.

DISCUSSION: Mr. Greathead appeared before the Committee in person in accordance with a Notice of the Board dated March 16, 2023. Mr. Greathead was not represented by counsel.

The Committee fully reviewed Mr. Greathead's petition for reinstatement and discussed the allegations in the Notice with Mr. Greathead.

CLOSED SESSION: Upon a motion by Mr. Bell, and duly seconded by Dr. Elariny, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Mr. Greathead. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Wood attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.


RECONVENE: Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and announced its decision.

DECISION: Upon a motion by Dr. Elariny, and duly seconded by Mr. Bell, the Committee made certain findings of fact and conclusions of law and voted to reinstate Mr. Greathead's license contingent upon completing certain terms and conditions.

VOTE: The vote was unanimous.

ADJOURNMENT: The Committee adjourned at 11:20 a.m.

As provided by law this decision shall become a Final Order thirty (30) days after service of such Order on Mr. Greathead, unless a written request to the Board for a formal hearing on the allegations made against him is received from Mr. Greathead, within such time. If service of the Order is made by mail three (3) additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of the Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.
