A formal hearing was held in the matter of James Joseph Kelley, Jr. to discuss allegations that he may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of pharmacy in Virginia and to consider his application for reinstatement.

CLOSED MEETING:

Upon a motion by Ms. Nelson, and duly seconded by Mr. Boone, the panel voted 6-0, to convene a closed meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711(A)(27) of the Code of Virginia ("Code"), for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision regarding the matter of James Joseph Kelley, Jr. Additionally, he moved that Caroline Juran, Ellen Shinaberry, Kiara Christian and Jim Rutkowski attend the closed meeting.

RECONVENE:

Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the panel re-convened an open meeting and announced the decision.

**DECISION:** 

Upon a motion by Mr. Lee, and duly seconded by Ms. Richards-Spruill, the panel voted 6-0 to accept the Findings and Facts and Conclusion of Law proposed by Ms. Kelly. Upon a motion by Ms. Richards-Spruill, and duly seconded by Ms. Nelson, the panel voted 6-0 to reinstate the pharmacist license of Mr. Kelley with certain terms and conditions.
