MARCH 2, 2012**

- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee (“Committee”) of the Board of Psychology (“Board”) convened on Friday, March 2, 2012, at 2:00 p.m., at the Department of Health Professions, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Henrico, VA.

- DISCUSSION:** Kathleen D. Mosby, Ph.D. did not appear before the Committee in person in accordance with a Notice of the Board dated January 12, 2012, to review allegations that she may have violated portions of the laws and regulations governing the practice of Psychology in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Dr. Mosby was not represented by counsel. The Committee fully discussed the allegations contained in the notice.
- CLOSED SESSION:** Upon a motion by Dr. Stewart and duly seconded by Dr. Falk, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711(A)(27) of the Code of Virginia for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Mosby. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Larimer, Mr. Opper, and Ms. Rothrock, attend the closed meeting, because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.
- RECONVENE:** Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee reconvened in open session and announced its decision.

**DECISION:**


