Additionally, he moved that Ms. Chappell and Mr. Opper attend the closed meeting, because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

RECONVENE:

Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee reconvened in open meeting and announced its decision.

DECISION:

Upon a motion by Dr. Walsh, and duly seconded by Mr. Mayer, the Committee made certain Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and voted to issue Mr. DeMasters a reprimand, and ordered him to obtain 6 hours of Board-approved continuing education in the area of boundaries.
