Additionally, he moved that James Rutkowski, Jaime Hoyle, and Christy Evans attend the meeting because their presence was deemed necessary and would aid the Board in

its deliberations. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the

requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Board reconvened in open meeting.

Upon a motion by Dr. Walsh, and duly seconded by Mr. Aguirre, the Board voted that in consideration of the evidence presented, Ms. Sample's continued practice as a licensed clinical social worker poses a substantial danger to the public and the license shall be summarily suspended pending a formal hearing. Further, upon a motion by Ms. Allen, and duly seconded

by Mr. Aguirre, the board voted to offer Ms. Sample a Consent Order in lieu of a formal hearing.

The vote was unanimous.
