Approval of Minutes

Anne Grindstaff, Auctioneer/Realtor and member of Virginia Auctioneers Association asked the Auctioneers Board to consider a grant to help fund a marketing class for auctioneers in January. Some of the topics covered in the class are branding, marketing, and social media. This is a topic under Other Business.

Public Comment Period

Regarding File Number 2017-00468, George Montgomery Bowman, the Board members reviewed the Consent Order as seen and agreed to by Mr. Bowman. Mr. Smith moved to accept the Consent Order which cites the following violations of the Board's regulations: 18VAC25-21-110.A.4

(Count 1); 18VAC25-21-110.A.4 (Count 2); 18VAC25-21-110.A.1.a (Count 3); 18VAC25-21-110.A.1.a (Count 4); and 18VAC25-21-180.4 (Count 5). For these violations, Mr. Bowman, agrees to pay \$100 for the violation contained in Count 1; \$100 for the violation contained in Count 2; \$150 for the violation contained in Count 3; \$150 for the violation contained in Count 5; and \$150 in board costs, for a total monetary penalty of \$1,150. If Mr. Bowman provides a current contract within thirty days of the order, Count 1 and Count 2 fees will be waived. Mr. Phillips seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Phillips, Smith, and Terry.

Regarding File Number 2017-00593, Michael E. Anderson., the Board members reviewed the Consent Order as seen and agreed to by Mr. Anderson. Mr. Smith moved to accept the Consent Order which cites the following violations of the Board's regulations: 18VAC25-21-120 (Count 1); and 18VAC25-21-180.3 (Count 2). For these violations, Mr. Anderson, agrees to pay \$300 for the violation contained in Count 1; no fee for the violation contained in Count 2; and \$150 in board costs, for a total monetary penalty of \$450. In addition for violation of Count 1, Mr. Anderson agrees to complete at least three (3) hours of Board-approved continuing education pertaining to Ethics and provide proof of attendance and successful completion within six (6) months of the effective date of this Order. The course(s) can be completed on-line or in the classroom. Mr. Phillips seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Phillips, Smith, and Terry.

Ms. Adams and Ms. Garbini excused themselves from the meeting.

Board members were provided financial statements for informational purposes. Ms. Nosbisch noted that the Board is financially sound.

After review of the letter from Mr. Damewood, Virginia Auctioneers Association, regarding grant funding and being mindful of Ms. Grindstaff's comments during public comment, Ms. Nosbisch reminded the Board that DPOR is totally self-funded through licensing fees; nothing is built into the budget for grants. She regrets there are no resources for funding grants.

Ms. Terry provided the licensee counts as of April 1, 2017: Auctioneers 1181 and Firms 249.

Ms. Nosbisch reported that there is a vacancy on the Board. She has been in communication with the Assistant Director of Appointments at the Secretary of the Commonwealth's office to find a replacement. Ms. Nosbisch noted that to have a quorum, a majority of the Board (three members) must be present to vote. She emphasized the importance of a
