For this violation Mr Jones agrees to pay a fine in the amount of \$50 00 as well as Board costs in the amount of \$150 00, for a total monetary penalty of \$200 00. Mr Garten seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members. Garten, Pence, and Wang. As the reviewing Board member, Mr Perkinson was not present for the discussion or vote.

William Walker was present to request that the Board take into consideration that he had not had a violation of the regulations in the past 15 years that he has been licensed.
