<b>Call to order:</b>	The meeting was called to order at 3:03 p.m. by the chair, Patrick McLaughlin. He stated that we are here to review the pediatric transport regulatory language and make necessary changes.

<b>Chair Report – Patrick McLaughlin:</b>	Dr. McLaughlin appreciates everyone coming to this Special Call meeting today. There is an opportunity to reword sections of the regulations. He spoke about the lack of a uniform, statewide transport system for each county and/or city. At the last Advisory Board meeting, there was some dissatisfaction with the lack of a virtual meeting option. It is his hope that we can get back to holding virtual meetings. Ron Passmore explained the rules of hosting virtual meetings by posting your meeting location to have the public attend the meeting at your location. Legislation action would need to occur in order to change the current rules concerning virtual meetings. The committee continued to discuss virtual meetings and its advantages.	
<b>OEMS Report:</b>	Tim Perkins announced that the Office of EMS has a partnership with HandTevy. Every licensed EMS agency in Virginia will receive a HandTevy Tape for each licensed EMS vehicle. The HandTevy app will integrate with our patient care reporting system. We are the second state to do this.
