<p>12:00 – 2:00</p>	<p>Working Lunch suggested by Chair and agreed on by members to allow meeting and discussion to continue</p> <p>Open Discussion: Dr. Scott Sullivan, Chair</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HB2111 Measure 4 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Action items: Members discussed recommending some enhancements to current maternal health benefits, with both Medicaid and commercial insurance providers in mind. <p>Home Visiting Programs- covering Lactation Consultants and Doulas. Nest Collaborative uses Zoom for services, but is covered by some insurances. Some Home Visiting services are covered by insurance: CHIP, can perform medical interventions with home visits. Nurse-Family Partnership, screenings for Post-partum depression and domestic violence.</p> <p>Social Determinants of Health Screening and Integration of care- covering screenings for birthing women in various settings to look for issues with housing, food, mental health, and domestic violence. PREPARE is a universal</p>

	<p>screening tools in use by Unite Us in multiple localities. Discussed “closed-loop referrals systems” as a way to provide better service follow-up and continuous care and accountability between care and service providers.</p> <p>State Funded Training Programs- Doulas, Midwives, Community Health Workers. Members agreed that Community Health Workers could have a great impact on maternal health without worsening the burden of physicians providing care. Can connect birthing women to needed resources and better provide warm hand-offs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The other 3-4 other recommended benefit enhancements will be brainstormed and discussed at next meeting. ● HB2111 Measures 1 & 2 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Action items Time did not permit discussion of recommendations for these measures. Task Force members tasked with brainstorming ideas individually and sending them to Coordinator.
